**IM/IT Privacy and Legislation Brach (PLB):** The IM/IT Privacy and Legislation Branch (PLB) is part of the Office of the Government Chief Information Officer. PLB is responsible for the following pieces of legislation and all policy, standards and directives that flow from them:

- *Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (FOIPP Act)*
- *Personal Information Protection Act (PIPA)*
- *Electronic Transactions Act*
- *Document Disposal Act*

In addition, PLB provides leadership, support and services to ministries and other public bodies to assist them in complying with their privacy and access obligations.

PLB also provides central agency comment and direction on information management and privacy matters in legislative, program and systems development initiatives and co-ordinates systems designed to manage and facilitate FOI requests and privacy responsibilities.

The IM/IT Privacy and Legislation Branch also monitors other legislation that is the responsibility of the Ministry of Labour and Citizens' Services.

## **Paul Kenneth Bronson Dagg MD FRCPC**

Paul Dagg is a Psychiatrist who has lived in Kamloops for the past 3 years. He is currently the Clinical Director for Tertiary Mental Health for the Interior Health Authority and Clinical Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry at UBC. Prior to coming to the Interior he was the Director of Clinical Services at the Royal Ottawa Hospital, Vice Chair of the Department of Psychiatry, and Assistant Dean for Postgraduate Education for the Faculty of Medicine of the University of Ottawa.
